## REGISTRATION

As in many sports and clubs, it is necessary to register with the governing body in order to participate and/or compete. The Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing requires registration of all dancers. ScotDance Canada is a sanctioned Agent. This registration will allow you to compete throughout the world.

## STATUS

The registration levels are progressive. Your dance teacher will advise you as to the correct level for registration. The annual fee is **\$26.00**.

## NEW DANCERS

New dancers may register at any time. Please include:

1. A complete dancer registration form
2. Two 3cm x 4cm photographs, signed by teacher, with dancer=s name printed on back
3. **A self-addressed, stamped envelope**
4. A photocopy of the dancer=s birth certificate

**ANNUAL REGISTRATION FOR ALL DANCERS COMMENCES NOVEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup>**(for the following year). Please return:

1. Previous card
2. A completed dancer registration form from your teacher when renewing
3. **Self-addressed, stamped envelope**
4. Premier dancers must also include two 3cm x 4cm photographs, signed by teacher, with dancer=s name printed on back.

## IF CHANGING STATUS, RETURN:

1. Previous card
2. Completed dancer registration form
3. **Self-addressed, stamped envelope**
4. Two 3cm x 4cm photographs, signed by teacher, with dancer=s name printed on back.

**\* Novice dancers who are moving into Intermediate must bring their Novice card to their first Intermediate competition in order to receive a temporary card. This temporary card will be stamped by the competition organizer and the dancer is to mail both the Novice card and temporary card to the ScotDance Registrar who will then issue this dancer an Intermediate card(see address below).**

Lost cards will be replaced at a cost of \$10.00.

All new registrations and annual registrations must include a cheque or money order for **\$26.00 payable to ScotDance Nova Scotia.**

## COMPETITIONS

Dancers must present their registration card at each and every competition. Non-registered dancers will not be allowed to compete at a registered competition. Registered dancers cannot compete in non-registered competitions. Dancers unable to present a card will have prizes withheld and an administration fee of \$5.00 may be charged. Awards will be sent upon confirmation of status.

While this registration will make you eligible to compete, some organizations hold competitions which are closed to members only. You may also choose to become a member of one or more Highland Dancing Associations.

## REGULATIONS

Registration indicates your commitment to abide by the rules of ScotDance Canada and the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing. Non-registered dancers cannot enter a registered competition.

**\*According to the Rules and Regulations of the SOBHD: Judges may not adjudicate their own students or students of relatives in championships or other competitions. Judges may not adjudicate at any event where their own students or students of relatives are competing. The definition of relatives being where the judge has knowledge of any competitor or teacher of a competitor being first cousin and above or legal guardian. If this situation arises, the dancer must withdraw form the competition.**
