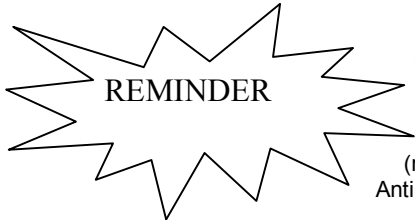

Competition Rules

- 1) Category changes must be e-mailed to Shelley Rovers at grantdancers@eastlink.ca ASAP. Late changes may not appear on program.
- 2) First to enter, last to dance. There will be no draw for positions in New Scotland Open Championship.
- 3) Competitor numbers will be issued on the field the day of the competition upon verification of current SOBHD dancer registration card. Dancer must present card to receive awards.
- 4) Entries postmarked after June 19, 2010 will be charged an additional late entry fee of \$20.00. Late entries will not receive their free pass. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
- 5) Dancing and scrutineering shall run according to SOBHD rules and regulations for competitions.
- 6) Competitors must report to stage area when event is called and may be asked to fill in for Reels when needed.
- 7) No coaching by teachers or parents while dancers are on stage.
- 8) In the event of a protest being lodged, a fee of \$15 must accompany a written complaint not later than 48 hours after the event.
- 9) The Antigonish Highland Society will not be responsible for lost articles or personal injury.
- 10) Dancers must be in full dress when receiving awards.
- 11) Medals will be awarded from Primary to Premier categories. All high aggregate winners with the exception of the Primary category will receive awards/gifts. All adult Premier Highland and Premier National categories will receive cash awards to sixth place. 1st place - \$40, 2nd place - \$30, 3rd place - \$20, 4th place - \$15, 5th place - \$10 and 6th place - \$5 No cash awards for New Scotland Open Championship.
- 12) In case of inclement weather, competition will be held at the Charles V. Keating Millennium Centre, St. F.X. University, Antigonish, NS.
